Explanation:

The total distance they will hike is 2.6 miles + 9.5 miles = 12.1 miles. If they hike 3 miles per hour, it will take them  $12.1/3 = 4.03$  hours to hike 12.1 miles.

What should a diver do if separated from the group?

**Answer: C**

Explanation:

According to the passage, a diver should spend only a moment looking for others in the group. If the others cannot be found, the diver should resurface.
